An extraordinary meeting of Hildersham Parish Council was held at Hildersham Village Hall on Wednesday, 3rd February 2010.

Present: Keith Day (Chairman), Dan Gresham, Jean Kelly and no members of the public.

The meeting started at 7.30pm

87. To discuss whether the Council would pay for the planning application for the new Village Hall.

Andrew Westwood-Bate, member of Hildersham Village Hall Trust, declared an interest in the discussion and absented himself from this meeting, in order to avoid any possible conflict of interest.

It was decided that, as Hildersham Parish Council own the Village Hall, although it is managed by the Hildersham Village Hall Trust, that the Council could make the planning application and fund the cost of the planning application. This decision was made after seeking advice from Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Association of Local Councils. The Parish Council would use part of the reserves that it had allocated towards rebuilding Hildersham Village Hall to fund the planning application. It was to be agreed, however, that this payment was not be seen as any form of precedent.

This decision was proposed by Dan Gresham and seconded by Keith Day.
