CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

RIDE

1. The ride will be over a course of about 15 miles to include plenty of optional fences. Make sure your horse is fit so you can enjoy the ride to the full.
2. Stewards with radio contact to the ride base will be stationed around the course.
3. First Aid and a vet will be based at the ride base and in radio contact with the stewards.
4. Refreshments given to all riders and half way point.

RULES

1. Those entering before 8th September pay an entry fee of £10.00 in advance of the ride. Riders must find their own sponsors and cannot start without paying the minimum sponsorship of £6.00 this may be paid in advance but **MUST** be paid before starting.
2. Those entering after 8th September and before 12th September **MUST** pay a late entry fee of £20 in advance.
3. Those entering on the day **MUST** pay a fee of £25.
4. All riders **MUST** pay £2 for First Aid cover.
5. Riders must declare at the Secretary's tent on arrival and the Secretary will allocate numbers. Numbers must be worn and will be provided on payment of **£2 returnable deposit**. On completion of the course the rider must report to the Secretary and return the number bib.
6. Hard hats must be worn, and attention is drawn to the British Standards design for hard hats and skull caps (and for your own comfort gloves are suggested). If you intend to jump body protectors are advisable.
7. No dogs will be allowed on the course.
8. No liability for damage to person, horse or property, however caused, will be accepted by the organisers or officials.
9. No horse under 4 years is to be ridden. All horses must be properly shod/trimmed. The organisers reserve the right to call for a veterinary opinion as to the soundness of any horse.
10. Riders are expected to show due consideration to other riders and the property over which they ride. The Committee reserves the right to ask any rider to leave the course.
11. Prizes may be subject to alteration.
