

WHO CAN STAND FOR ELECTION TO THE PARISH COUNCIL?

To become a Parish Councillor, you must fulfil the following criteria:

To qualify as a Candidate for Parish Council, a person must be at least 18 years of age and a Commonwealth citizen, or a citizen of the Republic of Ireland or a citizen of another Member State of the European Union and either

- a) be registered as a local government elector within the Parish; or
- b) have occupied as owner or tenant any land or other premises during the previous twelve months within the District/Parish; or
- c) his/her principal or only place of work during the previous twelve months has been in the area of the District/Parish; or
- d) have resided within the District during the previous twelve months (or in the case of a Parish Election within 3 miles of the Parish boundary).
